HIGH CONISCLIFFE BRIDLEWAY 1

Whereas the Borough Council of Darlington, being the Highway Authority, is satisfied that such restriction is necessary due to a weak bridge, the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(2) of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby gives notice of:

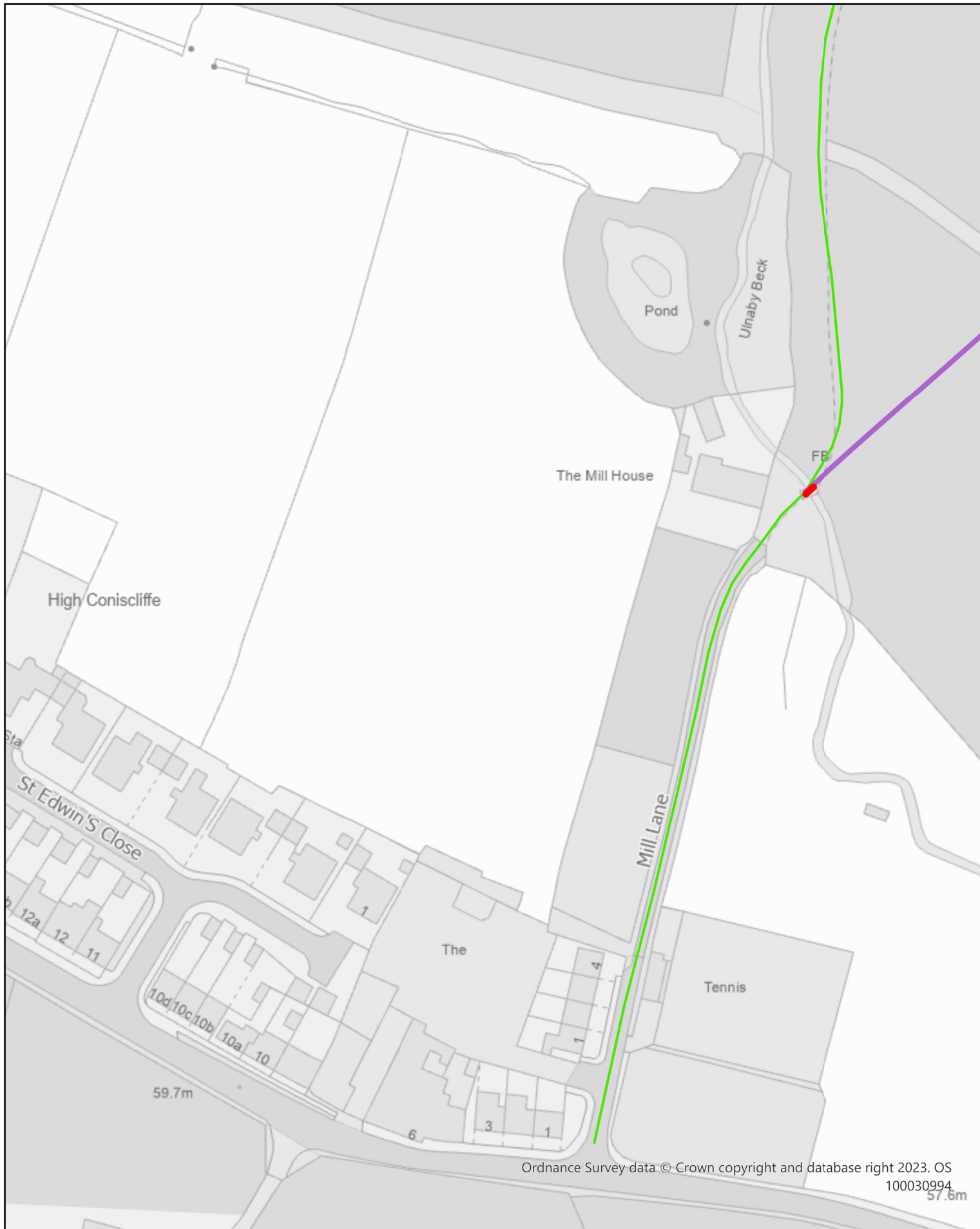
HIGH CONISCLIFFE BRIDLEWAY 1

Prohibition of horses on the bridge approximately 15metres northeast of the end of Mill Lane, High Coniscliffe

The maximum duration of the temporary restriction under this notice is 21 days commencing from 23rd January 2025.
