Prohibition of horses on the bridge approximately 15metres northeast of the end of Mill Lane, High Coniscliffe

The Order is necessary due to a weak bridge and the likelihood of danger to the public.

The maximum duration of the temporary restriction under this Order is 6 months commencing from 12th February 2025.
