(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, CLEARWAY AND SPEED LIMIT)

ORDER 2025

SADBERGE ROAD, MIDDLETON ST GEORGE

Darlington Borough Council has made an Order under the provisions of Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be:

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND CLEARWAY

SADBERGE ROAD - From the south side of the roundabout with the A67 southwards to the north side of Goosepool Way junction and from the north side of the roundabout with the A67 northwards for 58metres

An alternative route will be signed via Darlington Road, A67 and vice versa and via Middleton Road, A66, A67 and vice versa

30MPH SPEED LIMIT

A67 – from a point 50metres east of Sadberge Road Roundabout westwards to a point 50metres west of Sadberge Road Roundabout

The Order is necessary to allow road surfacing works.

The maximum duration of the temporary restrictions under this Order is 18 months commencing from 22nd April 2025, it is anticipated that the restrictions will be effective for 1 week.
